## **Transfer with Iron**



## Steps:

- 1. Prepare an Iron board or a flat timber board
- 2. Place the fabric onto the board, iron to remove wrinkles
- 3. Place the printed film on the fabric make sure the graphic face up
- 4. Switch off the steam function of Iron (140 -150°C)

- 5. Press the Iron for 15-20 seconds then move away, for big graphic, slowly move the iron back and forth (with even pressure).
- 6. Peel off the PET film only when the surface cool down.
- 7. In case of incomplete tranfer, place the PET film back or use a baking paper to cover the print and Iron press another 5-10 seconds.
- 8. Remove the film or paper.

**Tip:** Iron the print onto your garment using a hard surface (like a tile floor, piece of wood, or a cookie sheet, etc). For the longest life of your heat transfer: wash inside out in cold water with no fabric softener or bleach and tumble dry.

Note: This product will not adhere to nylon garments or products.
